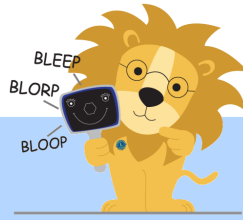


## Statewide Statistics



### Service Area

### Screenings

We provided vision screenings for **69,661 CHILDREN.**



### Referrals

We referred **3,870 CHILDREN** for possible vision problems.
